FORECASTED SEVEN-DAY TOTAL RAINFALL FOR 6TH TO 12TH MAY 2025

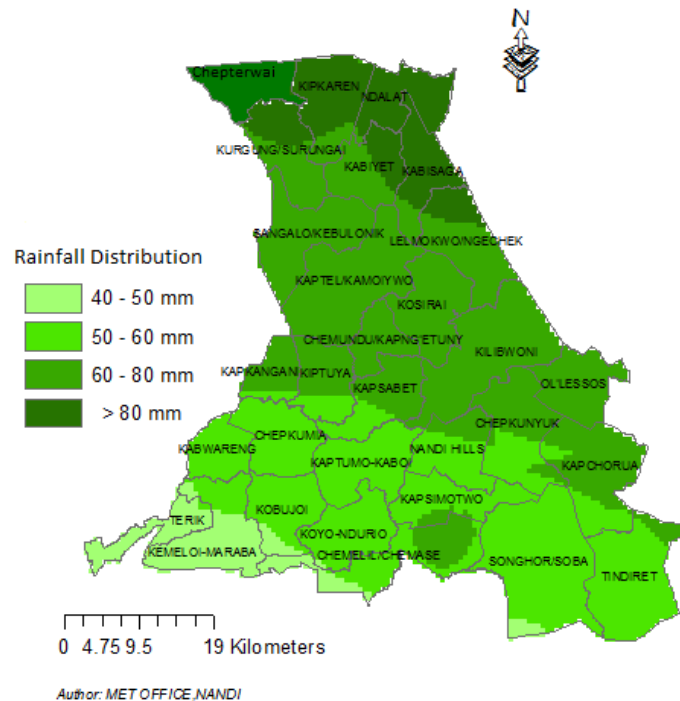


Figure 1: Forecasted Seven-Day total rainfall valid 6th to 12th May 2025



Period of forecast: Tuesday 6th to Monday 12th May 2025

General Outlook/Summary.

Rainfall is expected to continue. Moderate to light rainfall is expected over several parts of the county during the forecast period.

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- **Morning sessions:** Mainly sunny intervals expected during the forecast period.
- **Afternoon sessions.** Moderate rainfall covering many places is expected on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday. Moderate rainfall covering few places is expected on Wednesday and Friday. Light rainfall covering few places is expected on Monday. Isolated heavy rainfall over some parts of the county is likely to be experienced.
- **Nights:** Partly cloudy conditions expected in few days of the focussed period.
- Maximum temperature range likely to be 27-28°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 13°-15°C during the forecast period.
