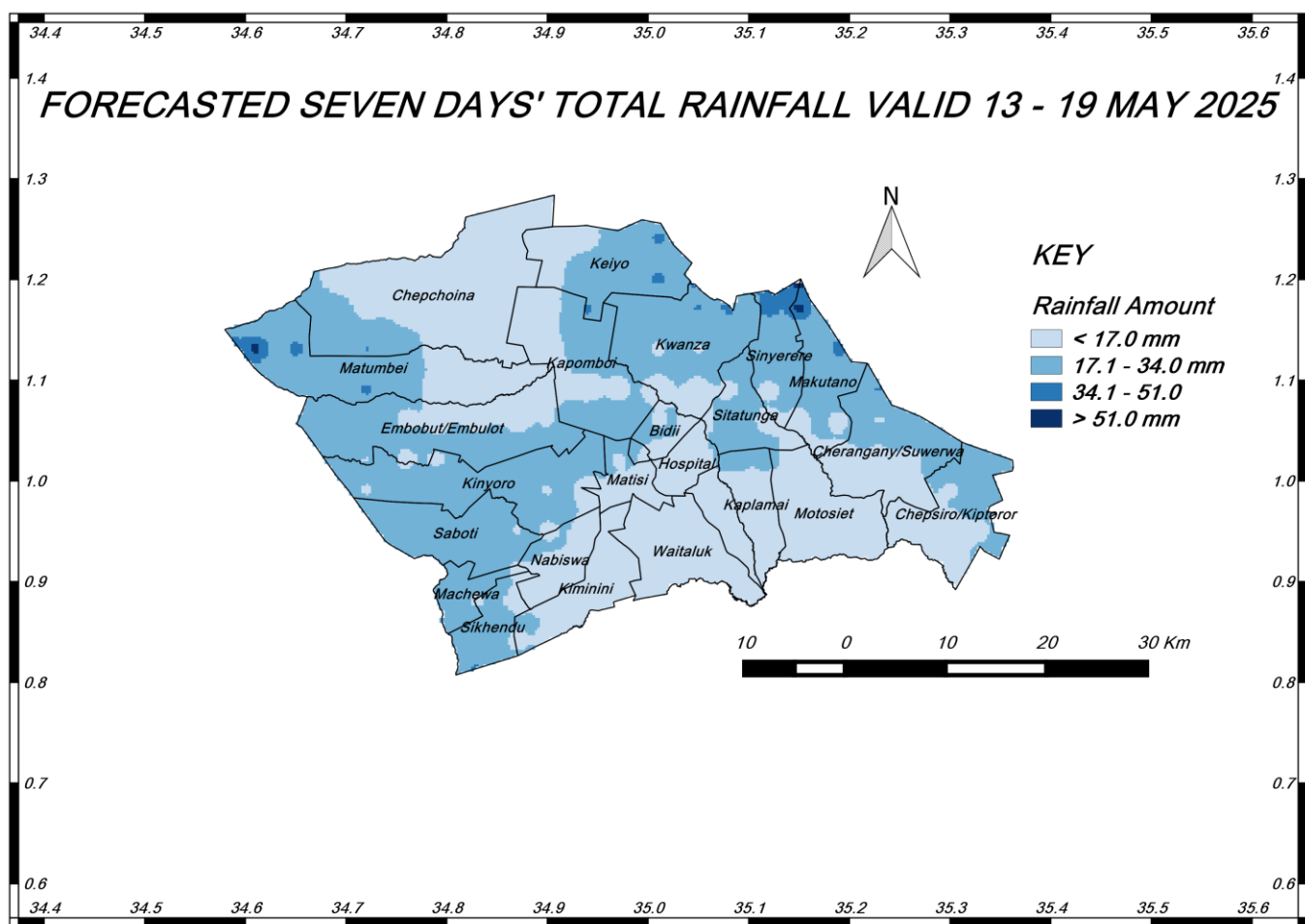

Key to rainfall distribution symbols:  rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%),  rain is likely to fall in many places (33% -67%),  rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

The weather outlook for the week of 13th – 19th May 2025, indicates some moderate rainfall activities within the County of Trans Nzoia which will reduce during the second half of the forecast period.

The forecast details are as follows:

- The morning sessions are expected to experience sunny intervals.
- During the afternoon sessions, moderate rains spread over several places are expected at the beginning of the forecast period. This will later reduce to light rains confined to few places towards the end of the week.
- The nights are expected to be have light rains over few places on Tuesday and Wednesday. The rest of the nights are forecasted to have partly cloudy conditions.

The weather outlook for the week of 20th – 26th May 2025, indicates that Trans Nzoia County is likely to experience maintenance of light to moderate rainfall activities over most places.
