SEVEN-DAY WEATHER FORECAST VALID 3RD TO 9TH JUNE 2025

HIGHLIGHTS

Forecast for 3rd to 9th June 2025

- *Light to moderate rainfall is expected to continue over the county during the forecast period.*

Weather Review 26th May to 1st June 2025

- *Rainfall was recorded over some parts of the county during the review period.*
- *Miyare Rainfall station recorded the highest weekly cumulative rainfall total of 58.7mm.*





Figure 1: Migori Climatic Zones

FORECAST FOR 3RD TO 9TH JUNE 2025



The county will continue to receive light to moderate rainfall during the forecast period. Central and eastern sector of the county are expected to receive significant amounts. Parts of Kuria west and east sub counties expected the highest weekly cumulative rainfall. (Figure 2)




Figure 3: Maximum Temperature forecast 3-9 June 2025




Figure 4: Minimum Temperature Forecast 3-9 June 2025

The day-time and night time temperatures during the period are as shown in Figure 3 and 4.

Figure 2: 7day cumulative rainfall forecast valid 3-9 June 2025



Commentary of County Weather forecaster:

- Sunny intervals are expected in the morning though occasional rains may occur over few places Afternoon and night showers and thunderstorms are likely to occur over several places reducing to a few places towards the end of the forecast period.
- Daytime temperatures are expected to range from 23°C to 29°C and night time temperatures to range from 16°C to 21°C.

Weather Review for 26th May to 1st June 2025



- There was a reduction in amounts and intensities during the review period.
- Miyare Rainfall station recorded the highest weekly cumulative rainfall amount of 58.7mm and also recording the highest amount within 24-hour period of 41.2mm on 27th May 2025. Other stations that recorded significant rainfalls are Sony Sugar (57.7mm); Koromangucha (55.5mm); Kuna-Ng'ope kamilewa (38.6mm); Ulanda AWS (31.9mm); Migori Dept' of Environment (31.9mm); while the rest of the stations recorded less than 30mm.
