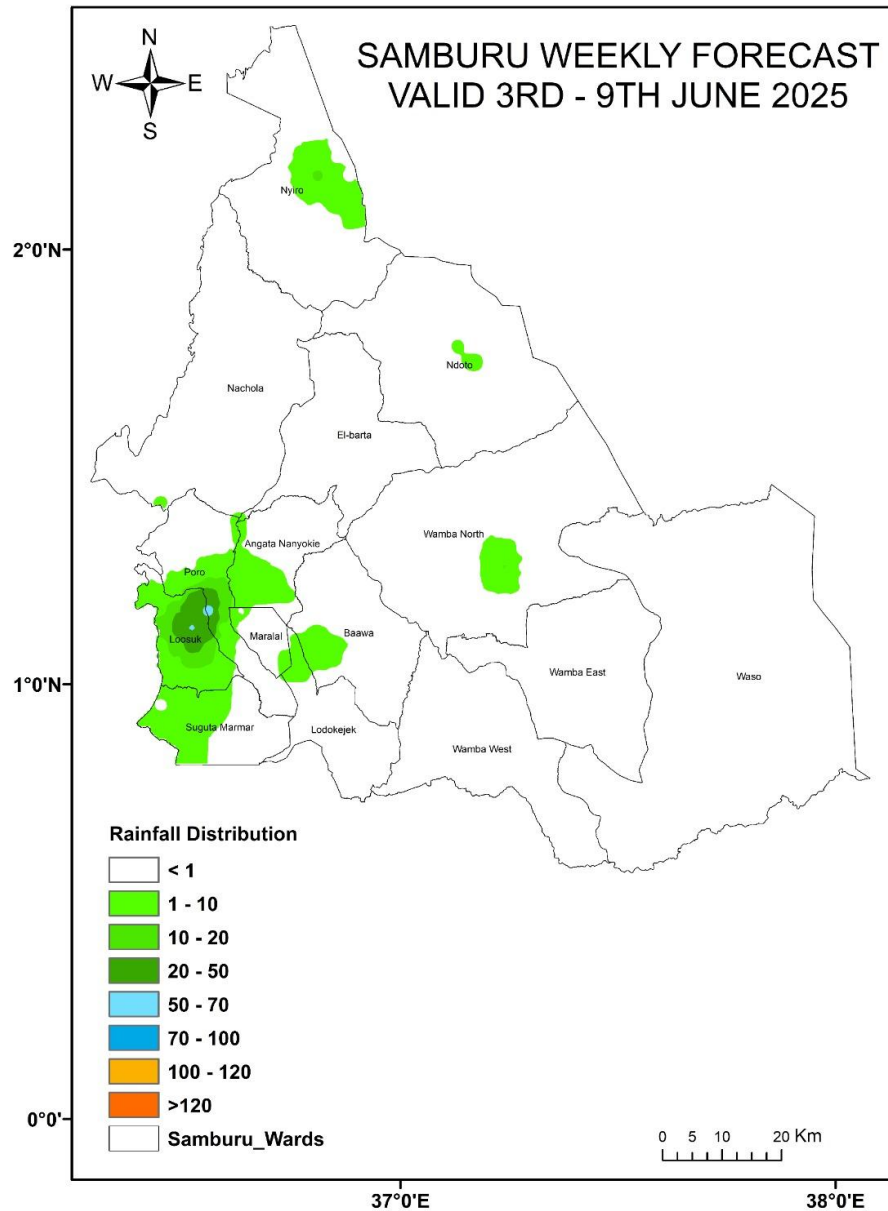


Figure1:Samburu County Cumulative rainfall forecast




The above graphic figure 1 depicts volume of cumulative rainfall amounts each ward in Samburu County is forecasted to receive from 3rd to 9th June 2025.

Commentary of County Weather Forecaster:

Samburu County is expected to experience sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period with light rains over Loosuk and parts of Poro, Maralal, and Sunguta marmar

- ❖ Sunny days and partly cloudy nights throughout the forecast period
- ❖ Maximum temperatures are expected to range between 31.0⁰C and 33.0⁰C
- ❖ Minimum temperatures are expected to range between 20.0⁰C and 21.0⁰C

The weather outlook for the week of 10th to 16th June 2025 indicates Samburu County is likely to experience wet weather conditions over few areas.
