Key to rainfall distribution symbols: \bigcirc rain is likely to fall in few places (less than 33%), \bigcirc rain is likely to fall in many places (33-67%), \bigcirc rain is likely to fall in most places (more than 67%)

Commentary of county weather forecaster:

- Morning sessions: Mainly sunny intervals expected during the forecast period.
- Afternoon sessions. Moderate rainfall covering many places is expected on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday whereas coverage of few places is expected on Sunday. Light rainfall covering few places is expected on Saturday and Monday. Isolated heavy rainfall over some parts of the county is likely to be experienced.
- Nights: Partly cloudy conditions are expected during the forecast period.
- Maximum temperature range likely to be 28-29°C whereas minimum temperatures range likely to be 16°-17°C during the forecast period.
