
# Weather& Marine Forecast for Kilifi County

# Weekly Weather forecast for Kilifi County valid 3<sup>rd</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 PART I: Weekly weather forecast summary

- > The County is expected to receive good amounts of rainfall on especially Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday '
- The rest of the week is expected to be dominated by sunny intervals with occasional showers in a few places.
- Moderate to heavy rains exceeding 20mm are expected on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 in several places as indicated in table 1.
- ➤ However, Ganze subcounty and a few parts of magarini hinterlands are expected to receive mainly light to moderate showers on Thursday.
- ➤ Maximum/Daytime temperatures are expected to significantly decrease, ranging from 25–28 °C in areas within the coastline and 26-31 °C in the hinterlands.
- ➤ The Minimum/Night temperatures are expected to remain unchanged ranging from 22-24 °C in areas within the coastline and 22-23°C in the hinterlands.
- Moderate to strong winds (6-13.5m/s) expected from Tuesday to Friday, then increase to moderate to very strong (7-14m/s) on Saturday, Sunday and Monday with mainly Southerlies.
- > There's need for caution from the night before Sunday to Monday this week due to strong inland winds.
- Rough Ocean conditions are expected from Sunday to Monday 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2025, while the rest of this week is expected to maintain moderate to rough conditions.
- Users of small vessels are advised to avoid venturing the ocean on 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> June 2025 due to high waves ranging from 2.0-3.0m.
- Users of small vessels are advised to venture with caution from 3<sup>rd</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> this week, due to moderate to strong winds(8-13m/s) and moderate to high waves (1.5-2.5).

### PART II: Meteorological advice to farmers concerning June to August KUSI season

- > The JJA season is expected to be characterized by near average rainfall in areas within the coastline.
- > June is expected to mark the cessation of MAM rains and the beginning of JJA -KUSI rains.
- Near average amounts of rainfall ranging from light to moderate expected in the month of June with likelihood of a few heavy rains episodes.
- The areas within the coastline and parts of semi-arid lands of the hinterlands are expected to receive near average rainfall ranging from 201-300mm.
- > Temperatures in JJA are expected to be higher than the climatological average, although maintain lower than the rest of the year records.
- > The month of June marks the beginning of KUSI –Strong Asiatic summer monsoons.
- ➤ General public and ocean users are advised to be cautious of chilly conditions and strong winds occasionally influenced by the monsoons.

### **PART III: 7day Marine weather**

Rough Ocean conditions are expected from Sunday to Monday 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 while the rest of this week is expected to maintains moderate to rough conditions.

- > moderate to strong winds are expected from Tuesday to Saturday, with wind speeds ranging from 8-13m/s.
- Moderate to high waves expected from Tuesday to Saturday with wave heights ranging from 1.5-2.5m.
- ➤ High waves >2-3m expected on 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>June 2025.

# ➤ Users of small vessels are advised to avoid venturing the ocean on 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> June 2025 due to high waves ranging from 2.0-3.0m.

Users of small vessels are advised to venture with caution the rest of the week due to moderate to strong winds and moderate to high waves.
