

# **GENERAL OUTLOOK**

# Morning sea state:

Light to breezy S winds (05-15 knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 4-5ft (1.2-1.5m) with short to moderate period waves of (10 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

### Afternoon sea state:

Light to breezy S to SSE winds (08-17 knots) with slight to moderate choppy seas. ESE waves of 4-5 feet (1.2-1.5m) with short to moderate period waves of (10 sec) are expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

# Visibility:

 Moderate visibility (9-10 km) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

## **COASTAL COUNTIES MARINE NEAR SHORE FORECAST**

#### i. KWALE

- Morning Winds: S 8 to 11 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 4 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Small mid-period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 10 to 15 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 4 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small mid-period waves.
- Sunrise; 6:31AM and sunset; 6:26PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: 9:13AM; 3.13m, 9:30PM; 2.63m
- Low Tide: 2:37AM;0.68m, 3:24PM;1.02m

#### ii. MOMBASA

- Morning Winds: S 10 to 13 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Small mid-period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 10 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 4 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small mid-period waves.
- Sunrise; 6:29AM and sunset; 6:25PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10 km)
- High Tide: 9:15AM; 3.1m, 9:32PM; 2.51m
- Low Tide: 2:39AM; 0.62m, 3:32PM; 0.93m

#### iii. KILIFI

- Morning Winds: S 13 to 15 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Breezy S winds with moderate choppy seas. Moderate mid-period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: SSE 13 to 17 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 5 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Breezy SSE winds with moderate choppy seas. Small mid-period waves.
- Sunrise; 6:29AM and sunset; 6:24PM
- Visibility: **Moderate (9-10km)**
- High Tide: 9:02AM; 2.87m, 9:19PM; 2.26m
- Low Tide; 2:28AM; 0.53m, 3:23PM; 0.82m

#### iv. LAMU

- Morning Winds: S 5 to 9 knots.
- Morning Waves: ESE 5 feet at 10 seconds.
- Morning sea state: Light and variable winds with smooth seas. Small mid-period waves.
- Afternoon Winds: S 8 to 14 knots.
- Afternoon Waves: ESE 4 feet at 10 seconds.
- Afternoon sea state: Light S winds with a slight chop. Small mid-period waves.
- Sunrise; 6:26AM and sunset; 6:26PM
- Visibility: Moderate (9-10km)
- High Tide: 9:03AM; 2.77m, 9:17PM; 2.15m
- Low Tide: 2:29AM; 0.49m, 3:26PM; 0.8m

# **Advisory**

- Slight to moderate sea conditions are expected with significant wave height of 1.2-1.5m in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.
- Light to gentle breeze of (05-17 knots) expected in Kwale, Mombasa, Kilifi and Lamu.

#### KEY ON SEA STATE

WIND	RANGE	DESCRIPTIONS	IMPACT
	<1-7 Knots	Calm to Light breeze	1 – 6 knots, the Ocean is relatively calm with very little disturbance. Suitable for Marine operations
	7 – 21 Knots	Gentle breeze to Fresh breeze	7-17 knots, small boats are likely to be filled with water sprays and become unstable. Caution in carrying out marine activities
	22 - ≥34 Knots	Strong breeze to Extremely Strong breeze	More than 21 knots, the ocean state is very much disturbed and the prevailing conditions are dangerous for marine operations. Warning in place!!!!!
